2. *The Autobiography of Shaykh Muqbil* by Muqbil b. Hadi al-Wadi’i (Al-Rahmaniyyah Press)
3. *A Daily Routine for the Seeker of Knowledge* by Muhammad b. Salih al-‘Uthaymin with commentary by Abd al-Razzaq al-Badr (Sunnah Publishing)
